- *Family history of arterial disease

- *50 years of age or older
- *Diabetic
- *High cholesterol
- *High blood pressure

Common Symptoms

- *Leg or calf pain when you walk
- *Pain stops when you rest
- *Tingling and numbness in your feet or hands
- *Cold legs or feet
- *Sores on your feet or legs that won't heal
- *Discoloration of the skin on your legs
